Parish Collections/Clergy Fund

I would like to say a sincere thanks to the people of the Parish of Borris, Ballymurphy and Rathanna for the financial support you have shown the parish over the years but especially in the last difficult months of Covid19 restrictions. I am aware that many people are finding it difficult financially at this time. While all the accounts are in the black one is very low and that's the Clergy Fund.

The Clergy Fund is what pays the Priests wages in the parish. To fund this there are four collections in the year; Christmas, Easter, Autumn and November Dead List. Due to Lockdown this year there was no Easter collection but I do thank all those who returned the envelope to the Parish Centre.

A Parish Priest receives €22,800 per year or €1,900 per month and is self assessed for tax etc. The Autumn collection now due and I call on your generosity in supporting this collection.

At present there is €970 in the Clergy Fund.
