And all who work in frontline services

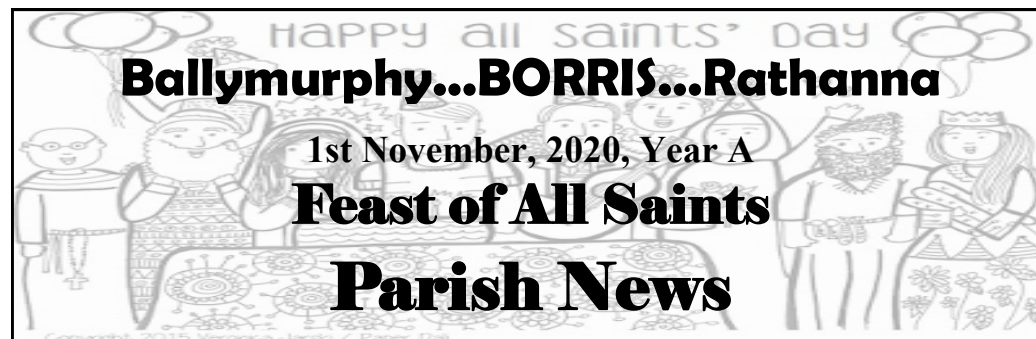
Give them courage of heart

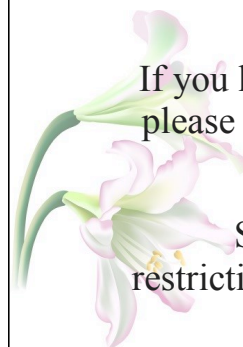

## *Covid19 Level 5 Lockdown*

Once again we find ourselves in a lockdown situation due to Covid19. It is with regret that this means a major impact for our Parish and Diocese.

**Masses:** No public Masses are allowed in Level 5, all Masses to go online from October 7th. All churches are to remain open for private prayer. (Times Outlined Below)

**Baptisms:** Planned baptisms for the coming days or weeks are unfortunately to be deferred until a suitable date can be arranged later.

**Funerals:** The maximum that can attend a funeral in Level 5 is 25.

**Marriages:** The maximum that can attend a wedding in Level 5 is 25.

This is very hard for everyone. We are lucky to have a web-cam in Borris church and masses will be broadcast as follows:

**Tuesday 10am, Wednesday 10am, Thursday 10 am and Sunday 11.30am.**

**The Church is open for private prayer Tuesday to Friday 10.30am to 1pm and Sunday 12noon to 6pm.** There will be no mass in Rathanna & Ballymurphy for the next 6 Sunday's at least.

During the Lockdown anniversary masses booked will be shared with the morning masses, a Friday evening mass will be shared with the previous Thursday morning mass and the Monday evening mass will be shared with the Tuesday morning mass.

In these uncertain and uneasy times let us pray for each other.
