

Tuesday 10am, Wednesday 10am, Thursday 10 am and Sunday 11.30am. The Church is open for private prayer Tuesday to Friday 10.30am to 1pm and Sunday 12noon to 6pm. There will be no mass in Rathanna & Ballymurphy for the next 6 Sunday's at least.

During the Lockdown anniversary masses booked will be shared with the morning masses, a Friday evening mass will be shared with the previous Thursday morning mass and the Monday evening mass will be shared with the Tuesday morning mass.
