

Covid19 Level 3 Lockdown

Once again we find ourselves in lockdown at **level 3 Covid19**. This means a relaxation of some of the restrictions of the past number of weeks.

Masses: Public Masses are allowed in Level 3, up to a maximum of 50 people may attend. Social distance and all Covid19 restrictions to be followed. All churches are to remain open for private prayer. (Times Outlined Below)

Baptisms: Can now take place with only immediate family members who need to be present at the ceremonies (to an absolute maximum of ten).

Funerals: The maximum that can attend a funeral in Level 3 is 25. **Marriages**: The maximum that can attend a wedding in Level 3 is 25.

This is very hard for everyone. We are lucky to have a web-cam in Borris church and masses will be broadcast as follows:

Tuesday 10am, Wednesday 10am, Thursday 10 am and Sunday 11.30am.

The Church is open for private prayer Tuesday to Friday 10.30am to 1pm and Sunday 12noon to 6pm.

Mass in Ballymurphy Saturday at 7.30pm & Rathanna Sunday at 9.30am.

During the Lockdown anniversary masses booked will be shared with the morning masses, a Friday evening mass will be shared with the previous Thursday morning mass and the Monday evening mass will be shared with the Tuesday morning mass.

In these uncertain and uneasy times let us pray for each other.
