## Celtic Rune of Hospitality

We often forget that Patrick was an immigrant – in modern terms we might call him an undocumented migrant or a slave. In his Confession he is described himself as a refugee: 'I am first of all a simple country person, a refugee and unlearned. I do not know how to provide for the future.' But through the grace of God, Patrick's fortunes were turned around and he embarked on a mission in his adopted homeland that would earn him the title 'Apostle of Ireland'.

Today we remember all migrants. In his message for the 104<sup>th</sup> World Day of Migrants and Refugees in January, Pope Francis said: 'Every stranger who knocks at our door is an opportunity for an encounter with Jesus Christ, who identifies with the welcomed and rejected strangers of every age. 'May St. Patrick guide us to be true disciples, with the courage to welcome every stranger as Christ in our midst.
