Glimpses of Heaven

At various points in the Gospels, we are treated to a brief glimpse of heaven – the baptism of Jesus by John, when the heavens opened and God's voice is heard; the Transfiguration where Jesus is transformed in the presence of Peter, James and John; and the Ascension, when Jesus is lifted up into heaven before the disciples' very eyes.

There are times when we get the sense that we have been treated to a glimpse of heaven – like when we are moved by a 'heavenly' experience, piece of music, sunset or breath-taking scenery. But today's feast of the Ascension reminds us that where Jesus has gone, we hope to follow. Elsewhere he tells us that he is going to prepare a place for us. We cannot imagine what lies in store in the life everlasting, the life beyond this life, which we hope to share with God. We can only see a reflection in this world of the splendour and beauty that awaits: 'The world is charged with the grandeur of God' (Gerard Manley Hopkins).
