What gives you the right? Who do you think you are? In our world, it can be difficult to work out who has authority to speak on certain issues. There are 'experts', both qualified and unqualified, at every turn, telling us how we should spend or invest our money, how we should eat, exercise or dress. We usually manage to tune a lot of it out. But when unsolicited advice or criticism is aimed directly at us, we can feel under attack and react accordingly. 'What gives you the right to tell me how to live my life?' is a common response. We sometimes need to hear someone's credentials before we are willing to give them a fair hearing.

The Temple scene in today's gospel sparks a debate about Jesus' authority. When the Jews question him, asking for a sign to justify what he has done, it is as if they are saying 'Who do you think you are, coming in here, criticising our activities and telling us how to run things? In calling the Temple 'my Father's house', Jesus has already identified the source of his authority, but his interrogators do not seem to understand, nor indeed do his disciples. This scene offers much more than an angry Jesus and a clueless audience. It is a public revelation by Jesus that he is the authoritative Son of God, and a foreshadowing of his death and resurrection.

Registering for WMOF: As of now, on-line registration is only open for the Congress that takes place in the RDS from August 22-24. When booking a one day or a three day ticket, as of now, people also have the option of booking a ticket for the Festival of Families on the Saturday evening and/or the Closing Mass on Sunday afternoon. Group registration of more than 15 people can be done without initially giving the names of the people. The name of a group leader is needed and a spread sheet is subsequently sent to this person to enter the details of attendees. Within the initial registration you can indicate the number of 1 day, 3 day, concession tickets you are looking for as well as the festival of families and closing Mass tickets (though each of the latter two cannot exceed the number of congress tickets being sought).
