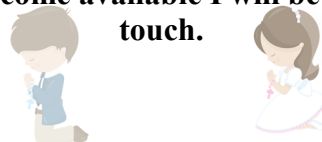

A Prayer for Workers During this time of the Coronavirus COVID-19

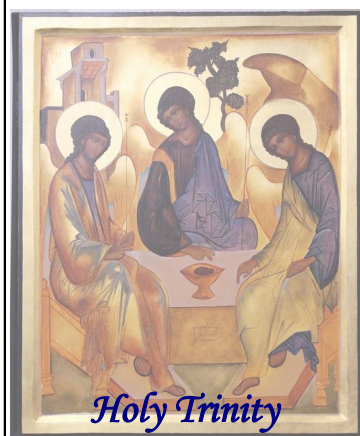
Loving God,

A Roadmap for Returning to Mass

I fully appreciate the desire of all of us, priests and people, to be able to return to the public celebration of Masses as soon as it is safe to do so. A Framework Document for a Return to the Public Celebration of Mass and the Sacraments is expected to be approved at the Bishops' Conference Summer Meeting early next week. This document will serve as a checklist to ensure your church building is ready for reopening. While the date of July 20th has been mentioned in the government's published roadmap, the more we can do now, the better chance there is to bring that date a little earlier.

It is essential that every parish establish a Covid-19 Support Team of parishioners to organise preparations for this eventuality and oversee implementation. It would be good to identify volunteers now who will help with the implementation. Every parish will need a supply of signage, cleaning/sanitising materials, once again it would be important to begin to source these now.

The Framework Document will address physical (social) distancing, hygiene and issues around liturgy. Every parish will have to carry out steps to ensure they are ready for reopening and these steps must be communicated to me at bishop@kandle.ie before a reopening is considered. Thank you for your assistance and cooperation.

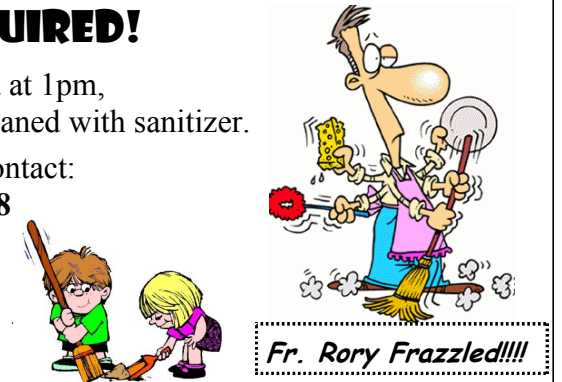
