Friday Penance

Penance is an essential part of the lives of all Christ's faithful. It arises from the Lord's call to conversion and repentance, a call that is central to the season of Lent.

We do penance:

- + in memory of the passion and death of the Lord,
- + as a sharing in Christ's suffering,
- + as an expression of inner conversion,
- + as a form of making amends for sin.

As Catholics we are encouraged to practice forms of Friday Penance throughout the year. The season of Lent is a time when we might be especially mindful of this practice. The following are suggestions from the Irish Bishops' Conference as ways of fulfilling Friday penance:

- + Abstaining from meat or some other food
- + Abstaining from alcoholic drink or smoking
- + Making a special effort at involvement in family prayer
- + Making a special effort to participate in Mass on Fridays (online)
- + Visiting the Blessed Sacrament
- + Making the Stations of the Cross
- + Fasting from all food for a longer period than usual and perhaps giving what is saved to the needy.


