There were many differing responses, including being eaten by a shark and being trapped in an earthquake, but two in particular caught the teacher's attention: being told I was ugly; being in a family who didn't love me.

The teacher thought these answers were probably the most honest because they revealed what is most critical to self-esteem – that part of us that recognises the connection we have with each other. Anything that threatens that tie – like being labelled ugly, unworthy or unfit, or out of place – through lack of love, is devastating. Especially if this is from within the family unit itself.
