Vocations Sunday... "Take the Risk for Christ"

"We all have our Vocation story to tell. It's not earth shattering but it's ours and we must own it. What attracted us to the life we live today? I encourage each of you to tell something of your own story next Sunday, as we begin a dedicated 'Year for Vocation to the Diocesan Priesthood' with the theme 'Take the Risk for Christ'.

Looking over the parishes where our vocations were nourished, taking the group of men in active ministry and those who are retired, it's interesting to see that our 79 priests come from just 40 parishes. There are 16 parishes that have no native son serving in the diocese. **The parishes with the most vocations to the diocesan priesthood are Carlow Cathedral and Tullow, followed closely by Borris and then Edenderry.** The County Carlow end of the diocese has had the largest number of diocesan vocations with 36 priests from parishes within the county.

We are blessed with men born in other parts of the country who are part of our diocesan family. We are further enriched by thirteen men from abroad who minister here and of course the Religious Orders, especially our friends in Kiltegan, who so generously give of their gifts, having served out on the missions.

As in our Synodal discussions and reflections across the diocese we honestly ask where and how is the Holy Spirit leading us? Is Ireland now a Mission territory as some suggest? It is. The fact is we will always need priests. However, before we can cultivate vocations, we must evangelise. There are still vocations here. There are still young men who generously give of themselves to the Lord, perhaps they need a little encouragement to take that risk for Christ".

Amen.


