Second Sunday of Lent

Every family has special moments that they remember and share again and again. In sharing these stories, the meaning and importance of these events develop and deepen over time. This is how it was with the disciples' remembrance of Jesus' Transfiguration. The full significance of what they had seen and experienced could only be understood after Jesus' death and Resurrection. As they told other believers about this event and recorded the story for us in the Bible, our understanding of what it means to call Jesus God's own Son has also deepened.

Perhaps when you meet or arrange to meet as a family this week you could think about some special family memories that your family tells over and over again. Talk about why these memories are important to you. Remember that in the Bible we find many important memories about Jesus that have been recorded for us so that we can believe that Jesus is God's Son.

Think of today's Gospel, Mark 9:2-10, the Transfiguration. What do we learn about Jesus from this Gospel? He fulfils the promises God made to Israel through the Law and the prophets. God glorified Jesus in his Resurrection. Jesus is God's Son. Pray together that we will deepen our understanding of and our love for Jesus. Pray together...

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.
